





Scone

Known as the 'Horse Capital of Australia', Scone is halfway between Newcastle and Tamworth on the New England Highway.

The rural town is surrounded by world class thoroughbred horse studs and is rich in agricultural and equine activity. Scone is a great base for the local driving tours and has a town walk to discover many points of interest. Pick up a town walks brochure at the Visitor Information Centre (VIC).

Scone is surrounded by lush bushland including world heritage State and National parks and it is the 'Gateway to the Barrington Tops'. Within a few kilometers of Scone, on Moobi Road, there is a petrified stump that is estimated to be 200 million years old. One of the best specimens in Australia, the tree was a type of Araucaria pine which is now extinct.

Every May is the Scone Horse Festival, a celebration of Scone's cultural links to everything equine. The Festival kicks off with the Horse Festival Ball and a parade in the main street. Then there is the rodeo, farrier competition, tent pegging, art exhibitions and regular horse stud tours which take place during the Festival. Visit horsefestival.com.au to book your tour.

The main event of the festival is the two day Scone Cup Carnival. The prestigious Scone Cup is one of the richest country racing days in Australia and the Friday is a half day public holiday in the region.

In 2020 the Scone Horse Festival celebrates 40 years. It is sure to be one not to miss.

Denman

Denman Nestled at the base of the Wollemi National Park and between vineyards, horse studs and olive groves, Denman is the Upper Hunter's centre for wine tasting and sampling local produce. Walk to Denman Lookout and cast your eye down the Hunter Valley and over to the extraordinary Wollemi National Park.

Don't miss the Two Rivers Sandstone Sculptures. These sculptures were carved onsite at Two Rivers in the winter of 2015 by international artist Ben Dearnley. More than 20 tonnes of stone sourced from the vineyard were used by Ben to create this unique and compelling project. His work directly references the ancient art form of stone masonry whilst reflecting the landscape of Denman.

The first European settler in the area was Lieutenant William. Ogilvie in 1825. This first settlement was known as Merton and was located on the opposite side of the Hunter River to the Denman of today. Gazetted in 1853, the town was named after Lord Denman, who later became Governor General of Australia. By the 1900s Ogilvie Street was bustling with small business houses servicing the town and outlying areas and the charm of yesteryear remains today. Denman holds some fantastic events including the Blue Heeler Film Festival in September, the Upper Hunter Wine and Food Affair in May and local favourite, Denman Pig Races in October.

Piercefield Camel Farm

Michelle Phillips and her family are passionate about camels and their farm in Muswellbrook is an oasis for these beautiful lumbering animals. Piercefield Farm produces camel milk and milk products and offers a unique farm tourism experience.

Several years ago Michelle saved 11 camels from slaughter, collected them from Victoria and brought them back to Muswellbrook. That number has grown to 70 and they are all part of an extraordinary enterprise known as Camel Milk NSW run out of Piercefield.


"We really love what we do," Michelle said. "When people come out to the farm and experience how we live, well that just feels amazing." Camel milk is said to contain excellent proteins for the immune system and has been used for centuries by nomadic people. The Phillips family are proud of their farming practices and welcome visitors and tours to the property. "Our camels are not fed any type of grain, they graze freely, live alongside with their mother in an organic approach to farming. "Our paddocks are rotated with sheep and chickens for natural fertilisation."

"It's a great feeling to be able to share what we've got with other people."



Murrurundi is one hour south of Tamworth and half an hour north of Scone and boasts natural beauty, rich farming land and plenty of character. This is the last stop before heading over the ranges to Willow Tree in the north and bidding farewell to the Upper Hunter.

Are you interested in art, antiques and cafes or just finding some local eclectic pieces for your home? Then the artisan village of Murrurundi may be just what you are looking for.

There are many art galleries and events by the Murrurundi Arts Council and the town's shops, cafes and pubs open their doors every weekend for you.

The King of the Ranges Stockman's Challenge, held the last
weekend in February, tests the traditional bush skills and
abilities of Australia's best stock men and women and is very
exciting to watch. The bush poetry, goat races
and damper making are all part of the fun.

Anytime of the year explore the unique rock
formation of the Eye of the Needle just past the
town's golf course. It is a fascinating walk
from Paradise Park to a lookout with
captivating views of Murrurundi.

Follow the town walk to view many of the Heritage listed buildings such as Dooley's Store and the White Hart Hotel. Copies of the Heritage

Walk map can be picked up from the Visitor
Information Centre. A favourite photo spot is the old suspension, 'swinging' bridge, built before

David Darcy

David Darcy started painting only a few years ago and was a finalist in the 2018 Archibald Prize for his portrait of fellow Murrurundi artist Charlotte Drake-Brockman. Before picking up a paintbrush, David had a successfu career in photography, publishing and film. Dogs have always been a passion and he is well known for his portraits and books on 'mongrels'. He has nine bestselling books and in his words has "chased dogs all around the world."

Now that he has taken up painting, he feels Murrurundi is the perfect place to have a studio and work in a community he is passionate about. "do a lot of portraiture work of local people who live in the Upper Hunter. I'm intrigued by this place where I live and the characters that live up here.

There's a real diversity of people and everyday I'm inspired. Someone might walk past the gallery or I'll meet someone in the park and I have a sense of urgency to capture this."

"There is a real sense of community and this is something I've never experienced before. People look out for one another and this is something I want to capture."

For David, it's not only the strong sense of community but the beauty of the landscape in the Upper Hunter.

"I can spend an afternoon cutting wood in the forest and drive down and think, wow, look where I am. Look where I've ended up. It's such a beautiful place. Every afternoon I sit out the back of the studio and watch the mountains and the clouds roll over and I'm dumbfounded by the beauty and the scenery around here. It truly is a beautiful place."

Aberdeen

Located on the New England Highway between Scone and Muswellbrook, Aberdeen sits on the banks of the Hunter River. With more than 175 years of history, the small town is steeped in Scottish heritage. One of the first settlements in the picturesque Upper Hunter Valley, the town was named after the Earl of Aberdeen, a friend of early settler and British MP, Potter Macqueen.

Today you can still see much of the history in a walk around the town. Plaques set in the footpath and on buildings identify historic places from Aberdeen's past. Copies of the map can be found at the Scone Visitor Information Centre.

Locals enjoy swimming and fishing in the clear waters that run down from Barrington Tops. Lake Glenbawn is just a few kilometres east of Aberdeen and well worth a visit. Bring the fishing gear - an abundance of fish are there for the taking. You'll find top Australian Bass, Golden Perch, Murray Cod, Trout and Catfish hiding in the depths. Also a great spot for a picnic and checking out the local wildlife.

The annual Aberdeen Highland Games take place on the first weekend in July and will be celebrating 20 years in 2019. The games are a gathering of pipe bands, Clans, dancers, the 'strong man challenge' and state and interstate tug-o-war teams to help celebrate the Scottish and Celtic history of the Upper Hunter.





Tartan abounds in Aberdeen

The Upper Hunter's first official tartan has been revealed and will be adorning scarves, ties, shawls and even kilts as well as signage and marketing materials for the region.

The tartan is based on Campbell of Breadalbane but tells the story of the Upper Hunter valley.

Green is for the lands where lucerne supports the dairy, beef and equine industries

Blue is the waters of the Hunter and Goulbourn river valleys.

White is the milk and cream that flowed from the valley.

Black is the black coal seams.

Purple is the grapes that become wine

Yellow is the golden cereal and canola crops and wool clips.

Red represents the Light Horse Troops and their horses from the Upper Hunter, who served overseas in World War I.

The project was put forward by the committee of the Aberdeen Highland Games, a festivalstyle celebration of Scottish heritage held on the first Saturday in July.

The first tartan was made from wool from Nundle Wool Mill and created by Fred and Marie Lawson, hobby crofters who run a weaving mill under the banner Crofters Tartan Weavers at their Spring Ridge farm in North West NSW.

Aberdeen Highland Games president Charles Cooke said the committee wanted to do something special to mark their 20th year.

Items in the Upper Hunter tartan colours will also be for sale at Visitor Information Centres across the Upper Hunter.
